

# Hong Kong International Track Classic and 2nd Cable TV Hong Kong International Track Cup (31 Oct – 2 Nov 2014)

**Date:** Hong Kong International Track Classic (Class 1) will be held on 31 October 2014.

2nd Cable TV Hong Kong International Track Cup (Class 1) will be held on 1-2 November 2014.

## **Participation:**

The maximum number of our invitation is thirteen (13) riders (maximum 7 Men and 6 Women) and two (2) officials for Elite Category and seven (7) riders (maximum 4 Men and 3 Women) and one (1) official for Junior Category.

## **Expenses:**

All the participating team will be responsible for the cost of their team's participation in the Hong Kong International Track Classic and the 2nd Cable TV Hong Kong International Track Cup including accommodation and meals. The organizer will provide the participating teams with special offer for accommodation, meals and local transportation from 30 October to 3 November 2014. The first meal will be commenced at the dinner on 30 October 2014 and the final meal will be the breakfast on 3 November 2014.

The details of the special offer, quoted in US Dollar, including accommodation, meals and local transportation are as follows:

The cost per person sharing a twin room is USD \$80.00 per night.

The cost per person in a single room is USD \$150.00 per night.

Any registration after the deadline designated in the following **Registration Procedure** will not be guaranteed for the accommodation reservation and additional cost may be incurred.

The expenses of round trip air tickets to Hong Kong and return ones from Hong Kong to the countries of origin will be borne by the participating teams. And the teams who send more members and arrive earlier as well as leave Hong Kong later than the dates specified above, should have to pay for their accommodation at US \$150 per day per person (on twin room sharing basis) and also have to be responsible for their meals by their own. If any team requires single room, the federation must inform the organizer before the team arrival. The expense for single room is US \$150 per day per person.

**Airport Transport:**

The Organizing Committee will be responsible for the transport to and from Hong Kong International Airport and the official hotels for each participating team. Airport pick up service will be provided from 30 October 2014 (THU) until 3 November 2014 (MON). **ONE** pick-up per team on arrival and **ONE** drop – off per team on departure will be provided. All the teams arriving before / departing after the aforementioned period of time will be charged a fee for this service.

**Rules and Regulations:**

The rules of this Tournament will be conducted in accordance with the latest Track Rules and Regulations of the International Cycling Union (UCI) under Class 1 event. In case of disagreement in the translation of the rules, the English text shall prevail. Any unforeseen cases not covered in the regulation shall be dealt with accordingly:

General issues: Resolved in accordance with UCI and The Cycling Association of Hong Kong, China Limited.

**Penalty:**

The UCI penalty is the only one applicable.

**Age of Competitors:**

Participation in Elite Categories shall be open to riders aged 18 and over\*. Junior Categories shall be open to riders born in 1996 & 1997 (18 & 17 years old).

\*Riders of the age 18 can decide whether they want to race the entire race as elite or junior.

#### Tentative Schedule:

#### Award:

Medals will be presented to the first 3 riders of each event

#### Uniform/Team Jersey:

Competitors must wear their National / Club competition jerseys under the UCI’s apparels regulations.

#### Team Managers’ Meeting:

The team managers’ meeting will be held at 1900 on 30 October 2014 at the meeting room of Hong Kong Velodrome. It is compulsory for team manager or team representative to attend the team managers’ meeting.

#### Team Representation:

Each National Federation / Club shall designate a Team Manager. The Team Manager shall represent the team and the National Federation / Club. Any contact with the teams shall be made through the Team Manager.

**Equipment:**

Equipment used in cycling competitions MUST comply with Chapter 3 of Part I of UCI rules and regulation. All participants shall ensure that his or her equipment (bicycle with accessories and other devices fitted, headgear, clothing, etc.) does not by virtue of its quality, material or design, constitute any danger to himself or to others. All equipment shall be checked by the commissaire before each event.

**Official Ceremony:**

Rider shall appear in racing attire, wearing their National / Club jerseys but bare-headed and without headband, sunglasses and also unnecessary item, until they leave the official ceremony enclosure. Any infringement of the provisions of article 9.1.044 to 9.1.050 above shall be fine of CHF 2,000 to CHF 10,000. A higher fine may be imposed depending on the advantage derived from the offence.

**Anti-Doping Control:**

To be confirmed by UCI or NADA of the host country.

**Insurance:**

All participants (include but not limited to team officials, riders and their assistants) are aware that they bear their own responsibility for any injury, accident and / or lost that may occur during their stay in Hong Kong while taking part in this Tournament. Participants should take up a properly insurance before leaving their country in order to protect themselves against any lost and to indemnify themselves against any claims.
