Participation:

OC ask you to send us the authorizing sheet which has prepared by your National Federation in accordance with UCI regulation (1.2.052). The written document should be sent with the name entry.

Expense:

Accommodation Fee and Transportation Fee will be borne by the participating team. If your team would like OC to make a booking for accommodation and transportation, we will inform you the contact of our official travel agency for your booking.

The accommodation fee is **USD120 per person per day** (including Breakfast and Diner) The Lunch Box fee is **USD 5 per meal** only available during the competition date (29th May – 1st Jun)

Confirmation of starters and Team Manager's meeting:

Confirmation of starters shall be done on 29 May 2025 at Izu Velodrome.

The team manager's meeting will be held on 29 May 2025 at Izu Velodrome
It is compulsory for the team manager or team representative to attend the team manager's meeting.

Team Representation:

Each national team/Club team shall designate a team manager. The team manager shall represent the team and the National Federation/Club team. Any contact with the teams shall be made through the Team Manager.

Equipment:

Equipment used in cycling competitions MUST comply with the UCI rules and regulations. All participants shall ensure that their equipment (bicycle with accessories and other devices fitted, headgear, clothing, etc.) does not by virtue of its quality, material, or design, constitute any danger to himself or to others. All equipment shall be checked by the commissaire before each event.

Official ceremony:

Riders shall appear in racing attire, wearing their National/Club jerseys, but bare-headed and without headband, sunglasses, and also unnecessary items, until they leave the official ceremony enclosure. Any infringement of the provisions of article 9.1.044 to 9.1.050 above shall be fine of CHF 2,000 to CHF10,000. A higher fine may be imposed depending on the advantage derived from the office.

Insurance:

All participants (including but not limited to team officials, riders, and their assistants) are aware that they bear their own responsibility for any injury, accident and or loss that may occur during their stay in Japan while taking part in this Tournament. Participants should take out proper insurance before leaving their country to safeguard themselves against any losses and claims.

VISA:

It is important to confirm with your travel agent or Embassy or Consulate General of Japan in your country if a visa is necessary for your travel to Japan.

The OC will be happy to assist each participating member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made via email by Mar 28th, 2025.

In order to expedite the visa process, it is advisable to request a letter of invitation as soon as possible.
