UCI Elite National Commissaire Course

About the Master Learning Facilitator (MLF): Loyal Ma is an International Commissaire in both MTB & BMX and resides in Rocky Mountain House, Alberta, Canada. Serving as a cycling official for over 35 years he has written and developed the curriculum for both these disciplines at the Provincial, National and International level. A former member of Cycling Canada Officials Committee he has also helped direct and write policy for National Officials in the Great White North. He was awarded the Cycling Canada's Commissaire of the Year award, their Cycling Builders Award, the ABA Presidents Award and the 2012 ASRPWF Officiating Recognition Award. In 2008 he completed the UCI Doping Control Officer course in Geneva, Switzerland and is a recognized Cycling Canada Technical Delegate for both BMX & MTB. He also serves as UCI International BMX Course Conductor and practical evaluator. USA Cycling contracted him to write their state level on line BMX Commissaire course in 2011. In the past few years he has delivered Comisario Courses in various Latin American countries. Loyal has been assigned to the Panel of 18 World Champs, 26 National Champs, over 100 International Events and the 2012 London Olympics and brings this experience to his courses. For 2017 he has been assigned to 12 C1 International events, and 2 World Cups. The first BMX Commissaire to be assigned to back to back Olympics in London and Rio. Yoda will share these experiences with Padawan in 3 ENC courses in 2017. In 2013 he was the Course Director for the Tour of Alberta and is back this year as the Technical Director for the Rocky Mountain House/Clearwater County Stage 3 Start in 2016. Loyal is also a Coaching Association Canada, National Coaching Certification Program Master Learning Facilitator and has taught theory & technical courses for cycling across Canada. This varied experience with teaching adult learners helps him keep his courses interactive, with relevant real world experience for the participants. He shares with all his participants the love and passion he has for both cycling and officiating to help them be the best they can be as a coach or official.

The UCI Elite National Commissaire Course is the first step in the evolution for candidates to become a UCI International Commissaire. Young Padawan will learn the essentials of officiating to become a BMX Jedi. This 4 day training course will assist in your personal and professional development and qualify you in your career path as UCI International Commissaire.

About the Course Facilitator

Mr Max Mager is a free-lance event cycling consultant. His involvement in the sport of cycling started back in 2000 as a volunteer with the Singapore Amateur Cycling Association (SACA), now called Singapore Cycling Federation (SCF). He then went on to assume the role of Vice President (MTB) in 2001 and 2002, before relinquishing this appointment to take up a paid position as General Manager from 2002 to 2005.

Apart from his administrative roles, organising the local race series for the association in MTB, BMX, Road, and Bike Trial, he has also been the national squad's Team Manager-Coach-Trainer in the South East Asian Games between 2003 and 2009 and at various Asian Championships for Road and MTB.

Max is an International Commissaire in BMX and MTB and has attended the International Road and Track Commissaires course.

Among the key highlights of his illustrious association with the sport includes:

- Competition Manager for Cycling, at the Inaugural Youth Olympic Games 2010 in Singapore.
- Panel of International Commissaires at the 2017 World MTB Championships in Australia, 2016 RIO and 2012 LONDON-Olympic Games, 2016 World BMX Championships in Colombia, 2012 World MTB Championship in Austria, 2015 BMX SX in Sweden and 2014 Asian Games in Korea, Oceania-Asian MTB & BMX Championships.
- President of the Commissaires Panel (PCP) at the 2017 UCI BMX World Championships in USA, 2016 UCI BMX SX in USA, 2015 UCI MTB World Cup in Canada, 2015 UCI BMX SX in Argentina, 2014 UCI MTB World Cup in Australia, 2014 '2nd Youth Olympic Games' in China.

Separately, Max has also lent his expertise as Project Manager for International races, and the construction of several MTB trails both locally and regionally.

He is an avid Mountain biker riding trails in Pan America, Europe, Oceania and Asia.
