In order for a category to be held, at least five riders must be registered and confirmed in that category following riders confirmation.

If less than five riders are entered in a category following riders confirmation, they will be combined with an older category. However, categories with a maximum age shall be combined with the next younger category.

Categories for Standard 20-inch bicycles cannot be combined with Categories for Cruiser 24 inch categories, and vice versa.

If the adequate numbers of five riders are registered and confirmed during the rider's confirmation, the category will be run even if less riders show up at the start, regardless of the reason, including injury or illness.

In any case where two or more categories are combined, the results of the combined categories must be split back into the original, separate categories based on the results summary

for the combined categories.

Also, the riders are awarded the prize that corresponds with their place in the separated results.

8 Eligibility

- (1) Age requirement: Minimum age is 30 (born on or before 31st December 1997)
- (2) To compete in any events in the Cycling competition at the Games, each athlete must hold a valid licence issued by their national federation of member of the Union Cycliste Internationale.
- (3) Exclude the following competitor: UCI ranking holder, at least 1 point. / Member of a team registered with the UCI.
- (4) A 'Special Event Licence' will be available for athletes who do not hold an annual

cycling licence.

Athletes can register “Special Event Licence” at the venue with valid identification (i.e., passport, driver's licence). The fee for this licence is 1,000 yen.

9 Consideration for persons with impairments who participate in the general category competition.

In this event, consideration shall be taken for participants with impairments in the general category competition. The content of consideration according to the types of impairments is the following:

Persons with hearing impairments

- **Making aware of the need for consideration by providing bibs, etc.**
Distribute bibs, etc. to make aware of the type of impairments if requested.
- **Accompaniment of a person to help an athlete with impairments**
Take care to provide a helper to accompany an athlete with impairments to the competition area.

10 Medal Ceremony

The Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded to the first, second and third ranked Persons by grade and by category.

The medal ceremony will be held after the end of all competitions .

11 Registration Fee

- Competition participants (Basic fee: allowed to participate in 5 types of competition across all sport)
 - a) Overseas participants: 24,000 yen/person
(Including a transportation pass for mobility within the Kansai area.)
 - b) Domestic participants: 15,000 yen/person
(Does not include a transportation pass. Can be purchased at additional cost.)
- Official/Coach, Helper, Partner (Basic fee)
 - a) Overseas participants: 14,000 yen/person
(Including a transportation pass for mobility within the Kansai area.)
 - b) Domestic participants: 5,000 yen/person
(Does not include a transportation pass. Can be purchased at additional cost.)

*When a helper (a person who assists a para athlete in a competition) participates in the competition to provide support, he/she is not required to apply for participation and is not required to pay a registration fee (provided, however, that the helper must apply for participation as a competition official when he/she requires a participant's kit, transportation pass, etc.).

13 Notes on Participation

(1) Clothing

(3) Insurance

The Organisers will take out accident insurance; however, the coverage is limited to injuries sustained by Athletes and Non-playing Officials during competition at the competition venue. The insurance coverage has a compensation limit and does not cover all risks to participants during the Games. Therefore, participants of the Games are advised to take out insurance against diseases and accidents (accident insurance, travel insurance, medical insurance, etc.).

(4) Doping Control

○ Doping control in accordance with the [World Anti-Doping Code](#) and [the rules of the International Masters Games Association](#) shall apply to this competition.

○ Anti-doping activities (doping inspections and anti-doping education activities) shall be conducted in accordance with [the rules of the International Masters Games Association](#).

○ By entering the Games, participants are deemed to have agreed to be subject to doping control procedures in accordance with [the rules of the International Masters Games Association](#) upon entry to the competition. Participants are advised to check [the rules of the International Masters Games Association](#) Rules for more details.

○ This competition aims to promote anti-doping activities as an activity to protect clean sports and clean athletes in order to leave various values of sports to the next generation through sports in cooperation with the Japan Anti-Doping Agency.

(5) In case of bad weather

The competition will be held in light rain, provided, however, that the decision on cancellation or postponement of the events will be made by the organiser and competition officials.

(6) Additional matters

① Participants must show a registration certificate (license issued by National Federation of the member of UCI) valid for the current year.

- ② Participants must take out liability insurance and accident insurance throughout the year.
- ③ Participants will be responsible for illnesses and injuries during the event and for expenses except of first aid.
- ④ Participants must bring their health insurance card.
- ⑤ The personal information stated in the participation application form may be used for checking the eligibility and communication on the event, as well as for listing the name, age, club, competition records, competition history, photos and the like in the posters, programs and communications, which may be published by mass media such as newspapers.
- ⑥ The portrait rights in the completion shall belong to World Masters Games 2021 Kansai and JCF.
