2.6.2 Transport Procedure

- ① All participants in championships have to reply to OC about team flight schedule before 16th September. If you don't reply to OC before deadline, participants will not be provided of transport service.
- ② Participants have to meet transport coordinator in arrivals hall and must comply with procedure.
- ③ Transport time is about 2 hours from Incheon airport to Velodrome. Bus and baggage trucks(Including cycle) will go the Official hotels via Velodrome.
- 4 All Participants will registered AD card after arrival hotels and then they are able to rooms check-in.

2.9 Access Control in competitions venue

Access the Velodrome is under control by the Korea Olympic Committee. Therefore, all participants must carry an AD card when entering the arena. Otherwise they can not enter the arena. And also please comply and respect to official route in competitions venue.

3.1 Regulations and Event

2020 Asian Track Championships shall be conducted in accordance with the Union Cycliste Internationale(UCI) Regulations and the relevant Rules and Regulations, in force during the time.

3.2 Participation

The age of participants by category is follows to UCI regulations. Only Junior category is follows to the rules as below.

The birth year of the junior category is 2001 & 2002. However, if you participated all of 2018 and 2019 junior championships, you can-not participate in the 2020 championships. Only athletes participating in one junior championships at that age can participate in the 2020 championships.

3.8 Shuttle Bus

The OC will provide shuttle bus from Hotels to Velodrome from official training day(October 14th) to end date of the competitions (October 21st). The time between hotels and velodrome is about 10 minutes.

3.9 Team Storage Area

Storage areas is located at basement level in velodrome. Size of storage areas will be allocated to the teams according to the numbers of riders confirmed. The equipment is managed through a 24-hour CCTV.

3.10 Infield Team Boxes

Team Boxes size will be allocated to the teams according to the number of riders confirmed.

3.11 Team Changing Room

The male and female changing room and shower facilities are first floor at velodrome.

3.12 Water Supply

During the training and competitions days, all team will receive bottle water and ice. Each teams receives water every morning at team service booths.

3.13 Team Performance Analysts

The video shooting and performance analysis area will be located at Back straight line. OC will not setup and support network system for the team.

3.14 Doping Control

The anti-doping controls will be under the Cycling Anti-Doping Foundation (CADF). Doping control room is located at 1st floor in velodrome.

3.15 Rider Safety Rules

The use of headphones and Action camera(Gopro etc) while riding on the track is forbidden.

The derny and starting blocks during the training are not permitted.

Standing starts are permitted for single rider only and shall take place only possible on the Home straight line.

3.16 Award Ceremony

The awards ceremony is held according to the schedule. The riders must wear the racing attire and jersey. During the ceremony, all cycling activities must stop for the respective of the ceremony. OC will prepare the flag and national anthem for each national team.
